Directions heading east on RT 15 from Cambridge: go straight through the Hyde Park rotary, continuing route 15E. The barn is .8 miles on the left.

Directions heading south on RT 100 from Eden: at the Hyde Park rotary, take a left on to RT 15 E/RT 100S. The barn is .8 miles on the left.

Exhibitors arriving day of show may arrive any time prior, and must leave within an hour of the conclusion of the show.

Class Descriptions

Green Horse/Pony- A walk, trot/jog only division. Riders 19 and over only

Costume Class- Open to all ages. Horses, Ponies, and Miniature Horses. May be lead, driven, or ridden.

Bareback Equitation (walk/trot, 18 & under) - Open to individuals 18 and under, to be shown at a walk and trot/jog both directions. No saddles or saddle pads can be worn by horses/ponies.

Bareback Equitation- Open to all ages, individuals will show at a walk, trot/jog, and canter both directions. No saddles or saddle pads can be worn by horses/ponies.

HGCF Therapeutic Showmanship- Open to all ages, individuals must be part of an equine based therapeutic program, to be judged on showmanship with equine shown in hand, standing and at a walk on the line; also on fitting, evidenced by grooming, condition, neatness, and sportsmanship.

Confirmation not to count.

HGCF Leadline Equitation- Open to all ages, individuals must be part of an equine based therapeutic program. To be led by an adult, walk only.

HGCF Therapeutic Equitation- Open to all ages, individuals must be part of an equine based therapeutic program. To show at the walk in both directions, trot/jog a few steps only at judges discretion.

HGCF Therapeutic Pleasure- Open to all ages, individuals must be part of an equine based therapeutic program. To show at the walk in both directions, trot/jog a few steps only at judges discretion.

HGCF In Hand Trail- Open to all ages, individuals must be part of an equine based therapeutic program. To show based on their performance over a minimum of 4 obstacles at a walk only.

Day End Championships are based on points accumulated in these classes offered.

HGCF Sportsmanship award: 7, 15, 21, 34, 45

Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion is awarded to the persons receiving the highest points received with same horse same rider of the day.
